- ▶ Cut out-of-route miles – preplan your route and keep side trips to a minimum.
- ▶ Take care of your tires – maintain proper alignment, check pressure and don't overlook trailer tires.
- ▶ Perform regular maintenance – whenever you spot a consistent drop in your fuel economy, some maintenance is in order.

## Winterize Now

**Five ways to give yourself a break instead of a breakdown.**

1. Outfit FUEL tanks with heaters or chemical additives to combat wax coagulation, prevent icing and maintain engine performance.
2. Rotate, inflate or replace TIRES to ensure proper traction.
3. Check COOLANT to make sure you're protected down to -30°.
4. Examine AIR and ELECTRICAL systems, replacing belts and hoses with cracks or leaks and making sure brakes, wipers, defroster, heater and exhaust systems are good to go.
5. Guard your PERSONAL SAFETY by preparing for emergency situations. Be sure to carry a blanket, ice scraper, sand or clay compound for traction, extra filters and a filter wrench.
